Abstract

First National Bank unveiled plans Monday for a \$250 million-plus development of residences and office buildings on 305 acres purchased from Boys Town.

The bank hopes to consolidate its west Omaha operations in as many as six buildings in the business park, situated on former Boys Town farm property between 137th and 144th Streets north of West Dodge Road.

The company will keep its headquarters at First National Plaza at 16th and Dodge Streets, retain its space at the former InterNorth Inc. building at 2223 Dodge St. and move, as planned, into space in the Central Park Plaza, 222 S. 15th St.
