Child Slaves Use Laid to I. G. Farben

NUERNBERG, Nov. 4. (P)— U.S. prosecutors introduced evidence today that I. G. Farben industries demanded, received and exploited slave laborers by the thousands, including children as young as 8.

Affidavits were introduced in the war crimes trial of 23 directors of the chemical trust from three condemned Nazi war criminals.

A statement was read from Christian Schneider, member of the Farben board, saying:
"In plants of I. G. Farben, foreign children from the age of 8 upward were employed."
