

On Board of Rockefeller Institute

Kenneth C. Brownell, industrialist; Eli Whitney Debevoise, lawyer, and Dr. Robert F. Loeb, physician, have been added to the board of trustees of the Rockefeller Institute for Medical Research.

Mr. Brownell, who lives in Greenwich, Conn., is president of the American Smelting and Refining Company, and a director of the Revere Copper and Brass Company, the General Cable Corporation, the Chase National Bank, and the First National Bank of Greenwich.

Mr. Debevoise, who lives at 925 Fifth Avenue, is senior

partner of Debevoise, Plimpton & McLean. He was general counsel to the United States High Commissioner for Germany and also assistant to the commissioner in 1952 and 1953. He also is president of the Russell Sage Foundation.

Dr. Loeb, who lives at 950 Park Avenue, is medical director of the Presbyterian Hospital, Bard Professor of Medicine at the Columbia College of Physicians and Surgeons, president of the Association of American Physicians, and former president of the American Society for Clinical Investigation.
