Ex-Chief of G.E. Named Interhandel Trustee

Directors of Interhandel, A. G., a Swiss company with interests in the General Aniline and Film Corporation, have named Charles E. Wilson as trustee for the Swiss interests, it was announced over the week-end.

Mr. Wilson, former president of the General Electric Company, will serve Interhandel in negotiations with the United States Government on the settlement of a fifteen-year legal controversy between them "to arrive at an understanding respecting the rights of ownership of Interhandel."

Charles M. Spofford of New York, a member of the firm of Davis Polk Wardwell Sunderland & Kiendl, will act as counsel for Mr. Wilson as trustee for Interhandel, John Wilson of Washington, D. C., of the firm of Whiteford, Hart, Carmody & Wilson, will continue to represent Interhandel interests in the litigation pending in the United States courts.
