ALBANY, March 7—The State Banking Department announced today that the Bronx County Trust Company, 2804 Third Avenue, the Bronx, has been authorized to issue five-year installment 4 per cent registered debentures due March 1, 1957, in the aggregate of \$400,000.

The International Banking Corporation, Bridgeport, Conn., was issued a license to maintain an agency in this state in the New York International Airport, Idlewild, Queens.

The organization certificate of the Royal Safe Deposit Company, 326 East 149th Street, the Bronx, was approved and filed.

The application of Bernard Rosenstein, doing business as Paymaster Check Cashing Service, 55-15 Grand Avenue, Maspeth, Queens, for a license to open a limited station at Industrial Container Corporation, Second Avenue and Sixtieth Street, Brooklyn, for the purpose of cashing checks, drafts or money orders for employees of the company was received for examination.
